Rodeo Added To Whoop-up Days Events

CONRAD — A rodeo has been added to the long list of attractions at the 19th annual celebration of Whoop-Up Trail Days here May 16-17.

Managed by Horace Raty of Square Butte, the rodeo will feature bronc riding, calf roping, bulldogging and wild cow riding. Raty will furnish the stock.

The celebration, which commemorates the days of wagon freighting between Fort Benton and Fort Whoop-Up in Canada, will get underway at 10 a.m. May 16 with a children's parade followed at 11 by the mile-long Whoop-Up parade.

The rodeo will be preceded at 1:30 p.m. by a pony show and races. Another highlight of the two-day event, sponsored by the Conrad Lions Club, will be a buffalo barbecue. Following the barbecue will be an Indian pow-wow, a talk by John Tatsey, colorful Heart Butte columnist, and an open air street dance.

Activities May 17 begin at 1:30 p.m. with a short Indian pow-wow followed by rodeo events.
